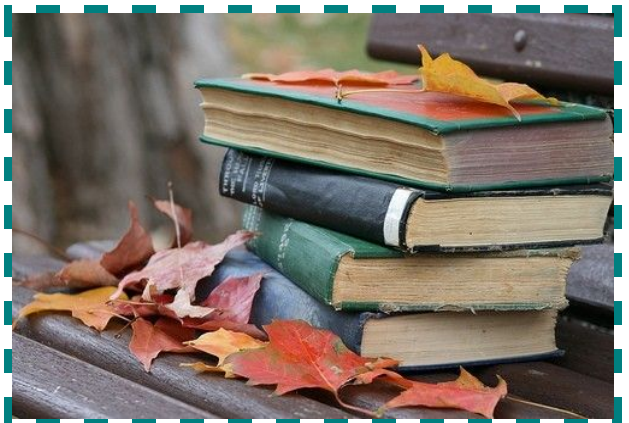
Remembrance Day Chapel:
